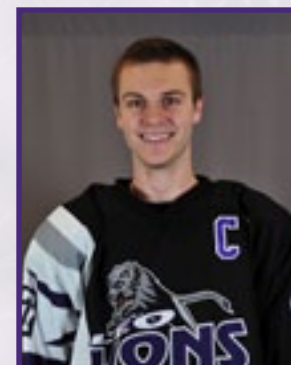

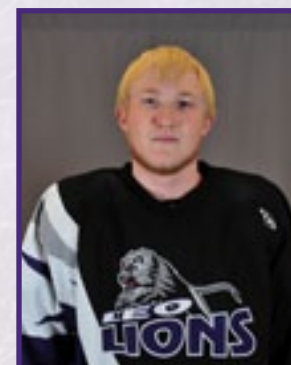
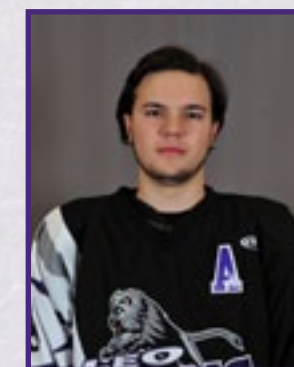


Zach Dailey

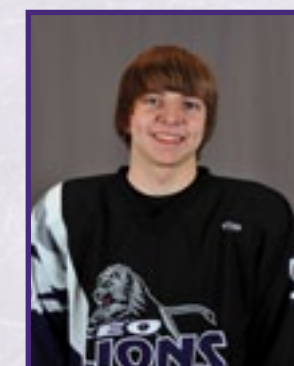


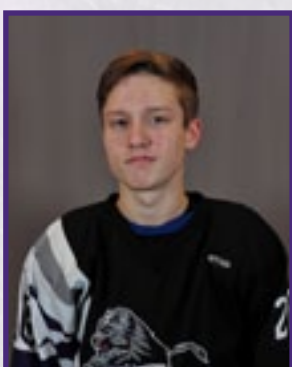
Tyler Harmon

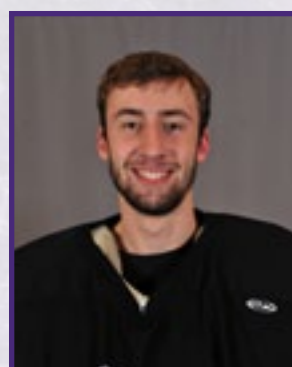


Logan Hoyer

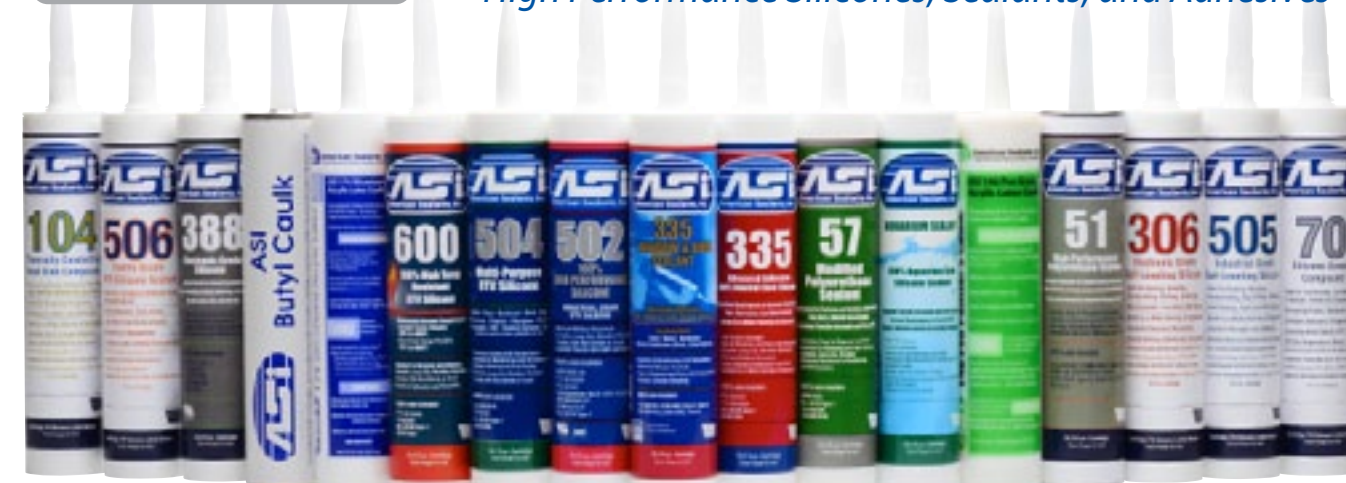

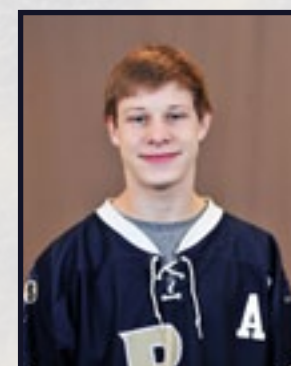
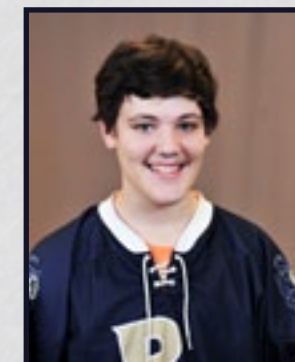


Tyler Bobay

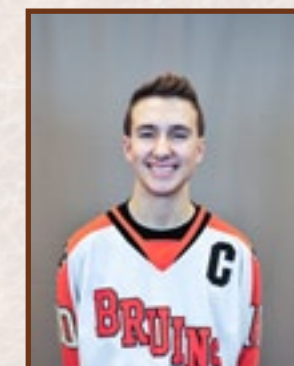


Dillon Moss

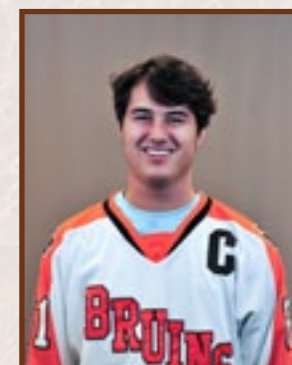
Cale Sanderson

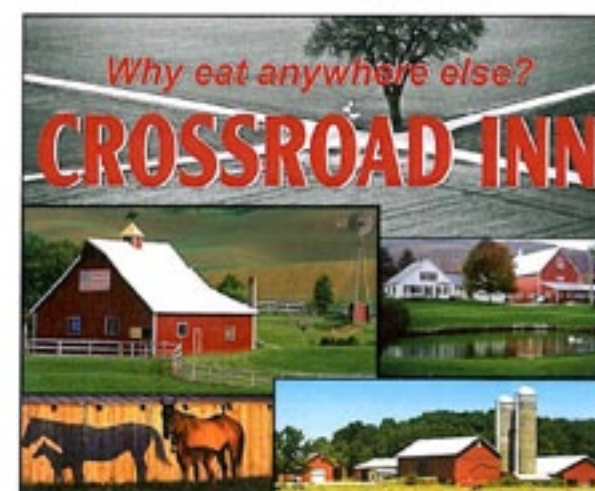

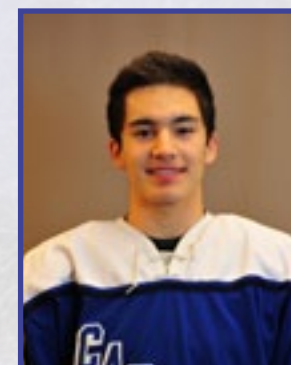

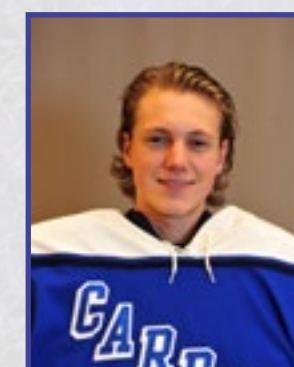


Austin Griffis

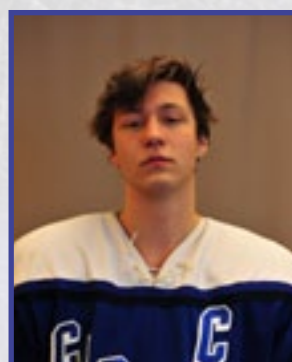


Jake Ramsey

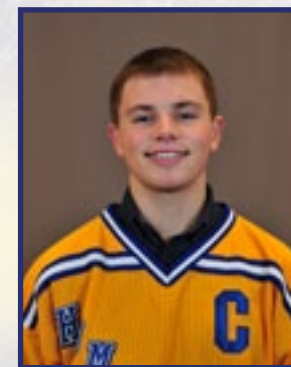

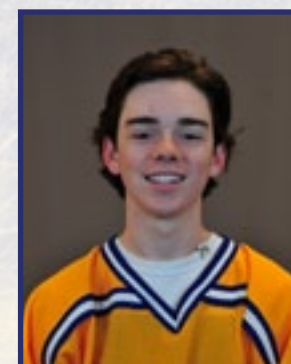


Tyler Fix

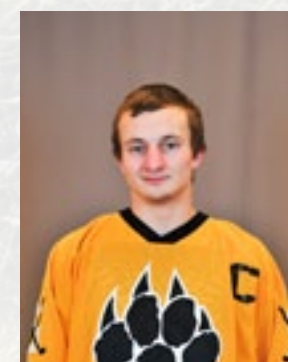

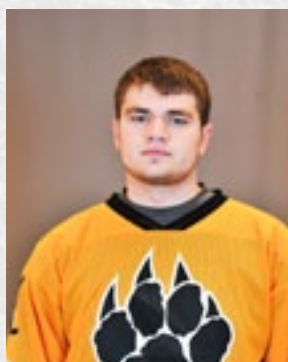

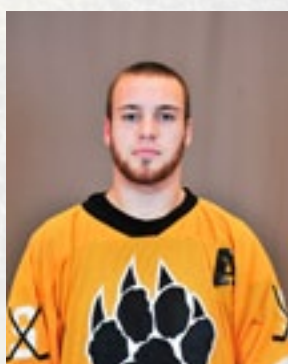
Jake Girardot

Justin White

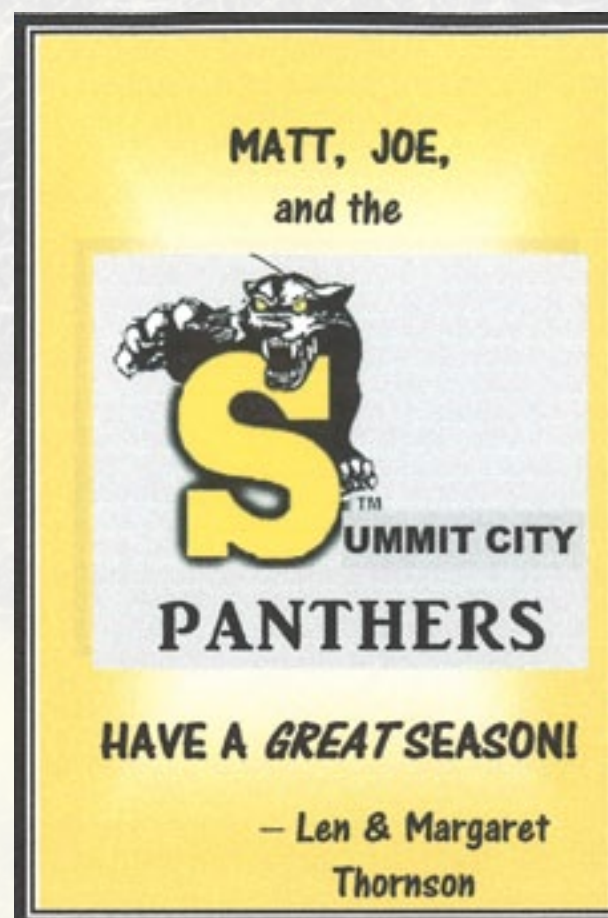
